Vice President Floeter announced the musicians of the Illinois Philharmonic Orchestra ratified the memorandum of agreement on June 6. A side letter including a code of conduct written be written by the union and the players committee.

Vice President Floeter reported the performance by Yandel Sinfonica at the Auditorium Theater on June 8 paid major event scale.

Vice President Floeter is working with Bach in the City on a CBA.

Vice President Floeter announced the ratification vote is underway for the agreement with Broadway in Chicago.

President Levy presented a request from the Chicago Federation of Labor regarding the annual Labor Day Event at McCormick Place on August 27.

MSC: to provide 2 musicians (2 musicians will donate their services) and donate \$1500 to the CFL Labor Day Event

President Levy signed a grievance settlement with Chicago Shakespeare Theatre regarding the *Lord of the Rings: A Musical Tale*. Four musicians will receive settlement payments in July.

President Levy reported the written agreement with Chicago Shakespeare Theatre has been verified and will go to a ratification vote.

President Levy reported on his attendance at the AFM Local Conference Council/ Players Conference Council meeting in Minneapolis on June 6-7.

Director Edwards has work conflicts with the June 17 and 24 board meetings.

President Levy discussed the June 9 new member orientation/ membership meeting.

The board discussed meetings with the Chicago Sinfonietta regarding educational concerts.

Director Daniels provided an update on Third Coast Music's scoring stage project regarding surveying the property, 600K in government funding and lobbying efforts.

Director Daniels recused himself.
